#### <u>The Qur'an</u>

dictated by Jibril to Muhammad – originally oral transmission, then faithfully copied down and transmitted Sura – chapter; aya – verse ("sign") Al-Fatiha – the opening sura, used as an invocation before public speech

**Global Muslim Communities** 

Sunni – "contractualist"; agreement about the teaching ("*sunna*") of Muhammad Shi'i – "intrinsicalist"; descending from the line of Ali, 4<sup>th</sup> caliph (656-661 cE)

Geopolitics and Muslim Worldview

Dar al-Islam – regions shaped by Islam Dar al-Harb – regions shaped by "the sword" (not accommodating of Islam)

The Effort ("jihad") of Muslim Commitment

Greater Jihad – maintaining personal commitment, witness, standards Lesser Jihad – defending Dar al=Islam and the community when the faith Is oppressed or under attack

Islam in America

Immigration – forced; economic; recruited labor; post-WWII political refugees and educational opportunity; Ugandan and Iranian refugees, and now Syrian Indigenous – Nation of Islam: WD Fard & Elijah Mohammed; Warith Deen; Louis Farrakhan

Number: 5: Five pillars of belief and practice sustain the Muslim life and community.

Color: Green – The prophet, Muhammed (PBUH), favored the green of nature and of paradise.

## Choose and aya (verse); read it aloud to one another and discuss it.

To each of you we [Allah] have prescribed a law and customs. If Allah had so willed, he would have made you a single people, but his plan is to test each of you separately, in what he has given to each of you. So strive in all virtues as if you are in a race. The goal of all of you is to Allah. It is he that will show you the truth of the matters in which you dispute. (*Qur'an* 5:48)

From those who call themselves Christians we [Allah] accepted a covenant, but they [too] forgot a good part of the message that was sent to them. So we estranged them with enmity and hatred between the one [Christians] and the other [Jews] until the Day of Judgment. And soon Allah will show them what it is they have done. (*Qur'an* 5:14)

Allah is the light of the heavens and the earth. Allah's light is like a niche in which there is a lamp, the lamp is in a crystal, the crystal is like a shining star, lit from the oil of a blessed olive tree, located neither to the east nor the west, whose oil would almost glow, even without being ignited by fire. Light upon light! Allah chooses whomever and guides them to the light. So Allah sets forth parables for humanity, for Allah has perfect knowledge of all things. (*Qur'an* 24:35)

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
