The Pastoral Residency Program of St. Paul Lutheran Church

Program design and context

The Pastoral Residency Program is designed to develop leadership skills and professional growth in gifted new pastors, strengthening the transition from seminary to congregational ministry in significant ways. St. Paul Lutheran Church, an active 3,500-member congregation with dynamic leadership, provides a rich setting in which to deepen pastoral identity. Residents develop their own insights and practices for good ministry. They become fully integrated into the life of the church as salaried first call pastors.

Eligibility

Seminary students in their final year of study or recent graduates who are candidates for ordained ministry are eligible to apply. Applicants who have a strong interest in congregational ministry will be given priority.
