Position Objective:

Oversee all aspects of children's ministries at St. Paul, giving special leadership attention to the engagement of families, the role of parents, the encouragement of volunteers, and all of the innovative, playful, and relational opportunities that children (birth -5^{th} grade) deserve when discovering the blessing of knowing Jesus Christ.

Essential Responsibilities:

Give focused attention to five key areas of responsibility:

- 1. Guide all facets of **Sunday morning learning** for children: The recruitment, training, and support of teachers, the evaluation and selection of curriculummodels, the oversight of periodic intergenerational experiences, and the building of an all-around happy environment for learning and discovery
- 2. Oversee the church's **Faith Milestones*** for children, working closely with learning and pastoral colleagues to engage families in joyously forming faith with their kids
- 3. Coordinate **special events** for children and their families (e.g. Vacation Bible School, Trunk or Treat, and other seasonal experiences), working with the children's ministries' assistant to create meaningful experiences that foster faith and a spirit of togetherness
- 4. Create **opportunities for parents** to engage issues, meet and know one another, and gain insights for good parenting and solid faith formation
- 5. **Build bridges with other staff colleagues and departments** to connect intentionally with children's choirs, children in worship, children in the Christmas program, etc.
