Sundays, 10:15-11:00 a.m.

Sunday Morning Learning will be offered for children from age 3 through 5th Grade. Registration and weekly check-in will take place in Lower Commons for K-5th Grade, and in classrooms for PreK. Masks will be expected for unvaccinated children and all classroom teachers and aides will be masked and vaccinated, until circumstances allow for a change.



DAYBREAK

Sundays, 10:15-11:00 a.m.

Sunday gatherings are offered each week for students in grades 6-8. Join Andy and Haley in the youth room where kids will develop a devotional pattern of asking questions, reading the Bible, and wondering and sharing about God.

FAITH MILESTONES

Faith milestones are special markers, grounded in the Bible and nurturing faith in everyday life. We discover God's presence in seemingly ordinary happenings.

1-year-olds | Faith Forming Beginnings

For parents of children born in 2021, connect and share in the joy and exhaustion of life with a newborn. Learn what it means to form a child's faith.

3-year-olds | Start Sunday School

Preschoolers are welcomed into Sunday morning learning. It's a big step into a classroom setting. Each child receives a colorful storybook Bible.

Kindergarten | Connecting to Worship

Kids ask questions and explore St. Paul worship. A monogrammed worship bag for each child adds to this fun family event.

1st Grade | 10 Commandments

Kids learn and discover the 10 Commandments and this gift of God's love, which provides guidance for navigating life.

2nd Grade | The Lord's Prayer

Children and parents learn together about the Lord's Prayer, a prayer that Jesus taught his disciples to pray.

3rd Grade | Explore the Bible

Kids and parents learn about God's written Word. Each child receives a Bible suited to a 3rd-grade reading level, along with a blessing in worship.

4th Grade | First Communion

Children and parents learn about the sacrament of Holy Communion. During the five-session Sunday-morning unit, each child creates a clay chalice.

6th Grade | Digital Identity

Texting, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Snapchat, YouTube, Twitch – parents and kids will explore identity and faith in a digital age.

7th & 8th Grade | Confirmation:

Students plug into the St. Paul confirmation experience. (More info on the right)

9th Grade | Blessing of the Keys

Parents and students come together for conversation about new responsibilities in life, including the ability to drive. A blessing is said over car keys.

10th Grade | Share. Save. Spend

This is a moment to pause and talk about money intentionally. Families of tenth-graderswill begin the conversation about money and examine our hopes and values.

11th Grade | Adventure trip

Students are invited to attend an adventure trip, preparing them for leadership in our community and exploring their faith stories.

12th Grade | Baccalaureate Breakfast

Parents and their graduating seniors gather for breakfast and conversation about the future. Students are sent off with a blessing during worship.

CHOIRS

Wednesday evenings | 6-6:30 p.m.

Bring your musical joy to a rehearsal (Sept-May). No auditions - everyone is welcome.

Alleluia Choir | Ages 4 to K Our smallest choristers learn songs of faith.

Jubilate Choir | Grades 1-3 Jubilate means to sing joyfully.

Cantate Choir | Grades 4-6 Learn the basics, including singing in parts.

Youth Choir | Grades 7-12 An energetic mix of music styles. This choir sings during Lenten Wednesday worship.

Wednesdays | 6:30-8 p.m.

St. Paul's confirmation ministry is a wildly popular experience that gets to the very heart of where 7-8th graders live. It's a creative, spirit-enlivened venture into a life of faith.

Each Wednesday combines interactive learning with pastors and other key leaders, explorations of the Bible, small-group experiences with dedicated adult sponsors, and worship moments. Games and activities "bring home" the evening's theme.
