Dimension 1: History

- A. 125 years in three broad segments
 - 1a. 1897-1923 First Zionist Congress to British Mandate and King Abdullah
 - 1b. 1923-1949 Mandate, conflicts, WW II/Shoa, UN 181 partition,

Israeli independence, Arab-Israel war, Arab "nakba"

2. 1949-1994 Arab-Israel wars; PLO; 1967 land lost by Jordan and Egypt;
Military administration and settlements
1979 Egyptian peace – Sinai returned; Gaza to Palestinians

1979 Egyptian peace – Sinai returned; Gaza to Palestinians 1994 Jordanian peace – West Bank to Palestinian Authority

- 3. 1995-present "Assassination of peace"; 2nd Intifada & violent resistance Settlement expansion and settler violence

- | I | US-Western/USSR contention during Cold War (mid-20th c. ce)
- | L | Saudi-Western/Iranian contention most recently

Dimension 3: Religion

Israel – 20% non-Jewish

West Bank & Gaza -2-3% Christian, and 6-7% of global Palestinians Religiously motivated minorities:

Israel: Religious Zionists, "Judea and Samaria"

Palestinians: Hamas, "Islamic Trust"


Dimension 4: Human Nature

Fear of annihilation – cultural and/or literal Honor/shame society and rational/justice society


Tribalism & fight/flight


