

The Pastoral Residency Program of St. Paul Lutheran Church

Program design and context

The Pastoral Residency Program is designed to develop leadership skills and professional growth in new pastors, strengthening the transition from seminary to congregational ministry in significant ways. St. Paul Lutheran Church, an active 3,500-member congregation with dynamic leadership, provides a rich setting in which to deepen pastoral identity. Residents develop their own insights and practices for good ministry. They become fully integrated into the life of the church as salaried first call pastors.

Eligibility

Seminary students in their final year or graduates awaiting their first call are eligible to apply. Applicants who have a strong interest in congregational ministry will be given priority.

The Application

Provide detailed answers to the application questions and submit all requested supporting documents.

- Cover letter and resume
- Application form completed
- Seminary transcript
- Two video sermons (manuscript if video is not available)
- Rostered Minister Profile (RMP)

Please inform your bishop of candidacy that you are applying to this program.

Deadlines

We accept applications on a rolling basis and our goal is to welcome a new pastor each August.
